Meeting Minutes for 9/28/2017

Attendance - There were 19 members in attendance.

Treasurer's Report –

- The banking information was reviewed in full.

Trail Masters Report

- The trail behind Wormel's will be open this year but the new development will create issues that will need to be addressed for next year.
- We will be re-decking the Brown Trout Bridge on Sunday 10/8. The Presumpscot Regional Land Trust has agreed to pay for half of the decking material. This translates to roughly \$450 in cost. The decking will be delivered to Bill B house and trucked to the site.
- The weekend of 10/8 will be used to survey the trails looking for any major issues like downed trees or major issues on the trails.
- The sign order has been delivered.
- We will be purchasing 4 sheets of 3/8" plywood for backers.
- There are stakes at Wally's that need to be cut down before they can be used.

Equipment Status;

- White Ranger needs anew sending unit.
- There was discussion on the cost to upgrade to the new designs of tracks. Wally C to investigate the cost of doing this and get back to us.
- The recall work on the Blue Ranger and the Sportsman has been completed.



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Old business update

- We're still investigating the fixes for Beaver Bog.
- We're waiting on a response from Shaw Brothers for the donation of a 4' diameter culvert.
- Remember you must be certified by the state before you can operate the grooming equipment.

Membership Report –

- Discussion on whether or not to send out mass mailings like we did two years ago. Discussions were tables until next meeting.
